
Tamworth to Newcastle Coach Rail Day Return





CURRENT STATE

NSW TrainLink currently operates one regional rail service from **Sydney** to **Armidale** and return each day stopping at Tamworth, three intercity rail services to **Scone** and one extra train to **Muswellbrook** each weekday. Two intercity trains run to **Scone/Muswellbrook** on weekends.

The current rail services in the **North West** allow one way travel in a day to **Newcastle** but no return option on the same day.

Around 600,000 journeys are made from this region each year, and around 550,000 to the region each year.



MARKET

The **Tamworth** area is expected to see growth over the coming years with the population expected to increase from 61,400 in 2016 to 71,050 in 2036.

This option could:

- service the growth area of Tamworth and provide connectivity to Newcastle University,
 John Hunter Hospital and Legal services; and
- provide connectivity to intercity services from Newcastle Interchange to Sydney providing an earlier arrival into Sydney than the current regional train.



THE PROPOSAL

Customers travelling from Tamworth to Newcastle

OPTION 1: Allow for a 8-hour stay in

Newcastle: Departs Tamworth at 4:00am,
connects with a train at Scone at 6:07am, and
arrives in Newcastle at 8:00am. Return train
leaves Newcastle at 4:29pm, arrives in Scone at
6:24pm to connect with a coach and arrives in
Tamworth at 9:00pm.

OPTION 2: Allows for a 6-hour stay in Newcastle: Departs Tamworth at 7:30am, connects with a train at Muswellbrook at 10:09am and arrives in Newcastle at 11:45am. Return train leaves Newcastle at 5:59pm, arrives in Scone at 7:53pm to connect with a coach and arrives in Tamworth at 10:10pm.

OPTION 3: Allows for a 4-hour stay in

Newcastle: Departs Tamworth at 7:30am,
connects with a train at Muswellbrook at
10:09am and arrives in Newcastle at 11:45am.
Return train leaves Newcastle at 4:29pm,
arrives in Scone at 6:24pm to connect with a
coach and arrives in Tamworth at 9:00pm.

Customers travelling from Newcastle to Tamworth

OPTION 1: Allows for an 8.5 hour stay in Tamworth: A train departs Newcastle at 3:20am, connects with a coach at Scone at 6:15am, and arrives in Tamworth at 8:10am.

Return coach leaves **Tamworth** at 4:45pm, arrives in **Scone** at 6:42pm to connect with a train and arrives in **Newcastle** at 9:00pm.

OR

Return coach leaves **Tamworth** at 6:05pm, arrives in **Scone** at 8:02pm to connect with train, and arrives in **Newcastle** at 10:45pm.



THE PROPOSAL (CONT)

OPTION 2: Allows for a 4-hour stay in Tamworth: A train departs Newcastle at 8:17am, connects with a coach at Muswellbrook at 10:15am, and arrives in Tamworth at 12:40pm. Return coach leaves Tamworth at 4:45pm, arrives in Scone at 6:42pm to connect with a train and arrive in Newcastle at 9:00pm.

OR

Return coach leaves **Tamworth** at 6:05pm, arrives in **Scone** at 8:02pm to connect with train, and arrives in **Newcastle** at 10:45pm.



TICKET INTEGRATION

Coach travel would require reservations but the rail portion of the trip is unreserved.

Tickets would be booked on line or through 13 22 32 with details in the Trip Planner.
