# Your guide to

# late-night transport in the Sydney CBD









Buses run along selected corridors all night, every night – these include routes 151, 301, 373, 380, 394 and 520. Additionally, routes 438, 607X, and M61 also operate all night on Fridays and Saturdays. Extra services also run on other routes early on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

A free bus service (route 300) runs from Kings Cross to Railway Square from 1.10am to 5.10am on Saturday and Sunday mornings.



#### **Ferries**

The last ferries from Circular Quay leave at various times between 6pm and 12.20am. See timetables or real-time transport apps for last service times.



## Light Rail

Services between Central and Dulwich Hill run every 15 minutes from 7pm. From Saturday to Thursday the last Dulwich Hill service leaves Central at 11pm.

On Fridays the last Dulwich Hill service leaves Central at midnight. Services between Central and The Star run 24 hours a day.

Overnight frequency is every 30 minutes from 11pm to 6am on Saturday and Thursday and midnight to 6am on Fridays.

#### **NightRide buses**

From midnight to 4.30am, when most trains stop running, NightRide buses replace train services on most lines.

#### **Taxis**

On Friday and Saturday nights, plus nights before public holidays, wait for taxis at a secure taxi rank. Secure taxi ranks are pre-paid between 10pm and 5am, so you may be asked to pay up front, before your trip begins.

- Customer service officers at secure pre-paid taxi ranks can help you estimate your fare.
- At the end of your trip, you pay the difference or get a refund based on the actual fare shown on the taxi meter. This includes applicable hiring charge and late-night or airport surcharges.
