Goulburn - Sydney Coach Rail Trial



CURRENT SERVICE

NSW TrainLink operates a mix of intercity and regional trains between **Goulburn** and **Sydney.**

Existing weekday morning intercity train services depart **Goulburn** at 5.30am, arriving into **Central** (with a change of trains) at 8.40am and departing at 7.34am arriving at 10.34am.

The evening intercity trains between **Central** and **Goulburn** on weekdays leave at 4.01pm arriving into **Goulburn** at 7.13pm and 5.48pm arriving (with a change of trains) at 9.02pm.

There are also at least five daily regional train services operating in each direction between **Goulburn** and **Sydney.**



THE PROPOSAL

NSW TrainLink proposes to trial new weekday coach services to provide alternative travel times for customers travelling between **Goulburn** and **Sydney.** These services will be operated in addition to existing trains.

The trial services would see a coach operating to and from **Goulburn** to connect with existing trains to and from **Central**.


In the morning the coach would depart

Goulburn at 4.20am to connect with trains at

Moss Vale and Campbelltown to provide an
arrival time into Central of 8.10am. This is 30
minutes earlier than the current first service.

In the **evening** customers returning to **Goulburn** will be able to catch a 5.20pm train to connect with a coach at **Campbelltown** for an 8.30pm arrival back into **Goulburn**. These services will operate via a number of towns including **Marulan** and **Bundanoon**.

In addition to these services, it is also proposed there will be a trial of a new **afternoon** coach and train service between **Goulburn** and **Central**. This service would see the coach departing **Goulburn** at 3.50pm connecting with a train at **Campbelltown** to arrive at **Central** at 6.30pm.





TICKETS

Opal fares will apply for the trial coach service, with customers using their Opal card to pay for the entire journey. Customers will tap on and off at the station.

Customers will need to make a reservation for the coach to ensure there are seats available for everyone, either by going online or by calling 13 22 32, and use their Opal card to pay when they travel.



Goulburn - Canberra Coach Trial



CURRENT SERVICE

NSW TrainLink operates three daily train services in each direction between **Goulburn** and **Canberra**. These trains depart **Goulburn** at 9.44am arriving in **Canberra** at 11.20am, 2.32pm arriving at 4.08pm and 8.29pm arriving at 10.03pm.

Services returning from **Canberra** to **Goulburn** depart at 6.45am arriving at 8.12am, 12.00pm arriving 1.27pm and 5.29pm arriving at 6.56pm.

THE PROPOSAL

NSW TrainLink proposes to trial new weekday coach services that would provide a convenient same-day return service for people travelling between **Goulburn** and **Canberra**.

This would enable people to travel from **Goulburn** to **Canberra**, stay at least five hours and then return to **Goulburn** on the same day. These trials will operate in addition to existing trains.

The proposed service will run between

Goulburn and Queanbeyan and include stops
at Canberra Hospital, John James Hospital,

Canberra Civic (CBD) and Canberra

Station.

In the **morning** the coach will depart **Goulburn** at 6.55am, arriving into **Canberra Civic** at 8.00am, then stop at **John James** and **Canberra Hospitals, Canberra Station** and **Queanbeyan** at 8.50am.

The afternoon return coach will depart

Queanbeyan Station at 1.50pm, Canberra

Station, the hospitals, then Civic at 2.40pm
to arrive back in Goulburn at 3.50pm.

Existing NSW TrainLink train and coach services allow an alternative return service from **Canberra** later in the day, including from hospitals and **Canberra's CBD**. This would see customers arrive back into **Goulburn** by train at 6.56pm.

Seats for the trial coach between **Goulburn** and **Canberra** will need to be booked prior to travel through NSW TrainLink, either online or by calling 13 22 32.


