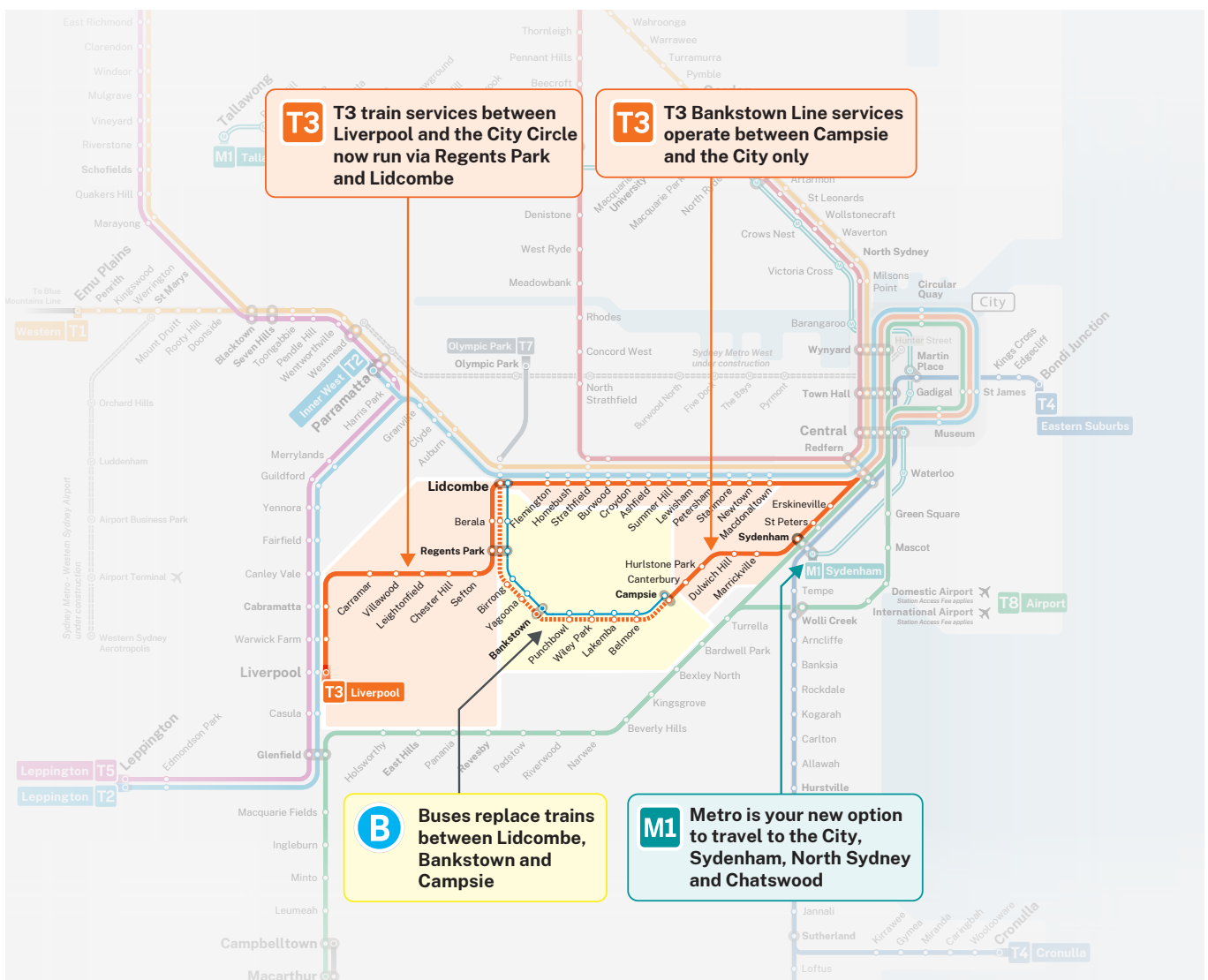


Buses replace trains on parts of the T3 Bankstown Line

Saturday 21 to Sunday 29 September 2024

T3 Bankstown Line closes between Birrong and Campsie for 9 days

- Buses replace trains between Lidcombe, Bankstown and Campsie.
- Trains run between Liverpool and the City via Regents Park, and between Campsie and the City, some to a changed timetable.
- If travelling between the City and:
 - **Birrong, Yagoona or Bankstown** catch a train to Lidcombe, then change for a bus
 - **Berala, Regents Park, Sefton, Chester Hill, Leightonfield, Villawood or Carramar** catch a direct train



Train replacement bus services



Lidcombe – Change for trains to City, Parramatta or Liverpool **T1 T2 T3**

Regents Park – Change for trains to Liverpool **T3**

Campsie – Change for trains to the City **T3**

Travel on these train replacement buses is free.

8T3: Lidcombe, then all stations to Bankstown and return

8AT3: Lidcombe, then express to Bankstown and return

18T3: Bankstown, then all stations to Campsie and return

Frequently asked questions

Why is the T3 Bankstown line being closed between Birrong and Campsie from 21 – 29 September 2024?

The T3 Bankstown Line between Sydenham and Bankstown will be closed from 30 September 2024 for up to 12 months while the line is upgraded to metro standards.

To support customers west of Bankstown Station during the 12 month conversion period, a new T6 train service will be introduced between Lidcombe and Bankstown. Regents Park will be the main interchange for passengers travelling between Bankstown and Liverpool.

The T3 Bankstown Line will be closed for 9 days between Birrong and Campsie from Saturday 21 to Sunday 29 September 2024 to allow for track upgrades and maintenance activities for the new T6 Line.

Will I have to pay to use the train replacement bus?

No. Travel on these train replacement buses is fare free – no need to tap on and off.

Will my journey time increase?

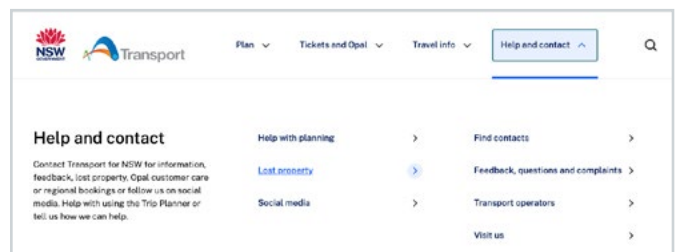
Yes. Passengers should allow extra travel time to complete their journey between Birrong and Campsie during the closure. Passengers will be able to plan their trip at least two weeks ahead of services starting.

Will stations remain open during the line closure?

Bankstown Station concourse will remain open to customers during the line closure. Birrong, Yagoona, Punchbowl, Wiley Park, Lakemba and Belmore stations will be closed completely during the 9 day period, including concourses and toilet facilities within stations.

I left something on one of the buses. How do I contact lost property?

Customers should visit the transportnsw.info website or call 131 500 for lost property. The form for lost property can be accessed via the 'Help and contact' section.



Where can I find more information?

It's important for passengers to consider trip options and allow extra travel time. Passengers will be able to plan their trip via the Trip Planner on transportnsw.info at least two weeks ahead of services starting.

Accessibility

Not all replacement buses will be accessible. If a passenger is using a wheelchair or mobility scooter, they will need to let the bus driver know and necessary alternative transport options will be arranged.
