



Overnight road work on the Southwest Link bus route, Dulwich Hill to Hurlstone Park from Wednesday 6 May 2026

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal peoples of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out essential road maintenance on the Southwest Link bus route between Dulwich Hill and Hurlstone Park to ensure bus services can continue to operate safely and efficiently.

We thank the community for their patience and understanding while we complete this important work.

What work are we doing?

The work will involve road repairs, asphaltting and new line marking across three sections of Ewart and Floss streets, between Wardell Road and Duntroon Street.

We will complete repair work across all sections first, followed by asphaltting and then line marking.

When will we be working?

We will work for up to **12 nights** from **Wednesday 6 May to Thursday 28 May 2026**, weather and site conditions permitting.

We will work from **Sunday to Thursday**, between **8pm and 5am** the next day. We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights.

What will this mean for you?

We will work at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks for our workers, pedestrians, bus users and motorists. This work may be noisy at times, however we will minimise impacts where possible, including completing noisier work before midnight.

Traffic changes and detours

A 40km/h speed limit will be in place and sections of Ewart and Floss streets will be closed during our work, with detours for motorists and buses. Please follow speed limits and the directions of traffic controllers and signage.

Parking and driveway access changes during our work

On-street parking will be temporarily removed on both sides of the street. Parking will also be removed on Duntroon Street to provide a temporary bus stop during work on Floss Street.

Driveway access will not be permitted in the work area during repair work. During asphaltting, access will be managed under traffic control and residents may need to wait up to 45 minutes before using their driveway.

Traffic controllers will be available to assist and prioritise access in case of an emergency. If you require access to a disabled parking space or have specific access needs, please contact us to discuss arrangements.

We encourage residents to park in nearby side streets when we are working near your property.

Bus stop changes on Ewart and Floss streets

During work on Ewart Street (Section A), bus stop 220448 will be temporarily relocated approximately 60 metres east along Ewart Street for SW1 and N40 services.

During work on Floss Street (Section C), bus stops 219311 and 219312 will be temporarily relocated to Duntroon Street for SW1, 406, 418 and N40 services. Please see the map over the page for further detail.

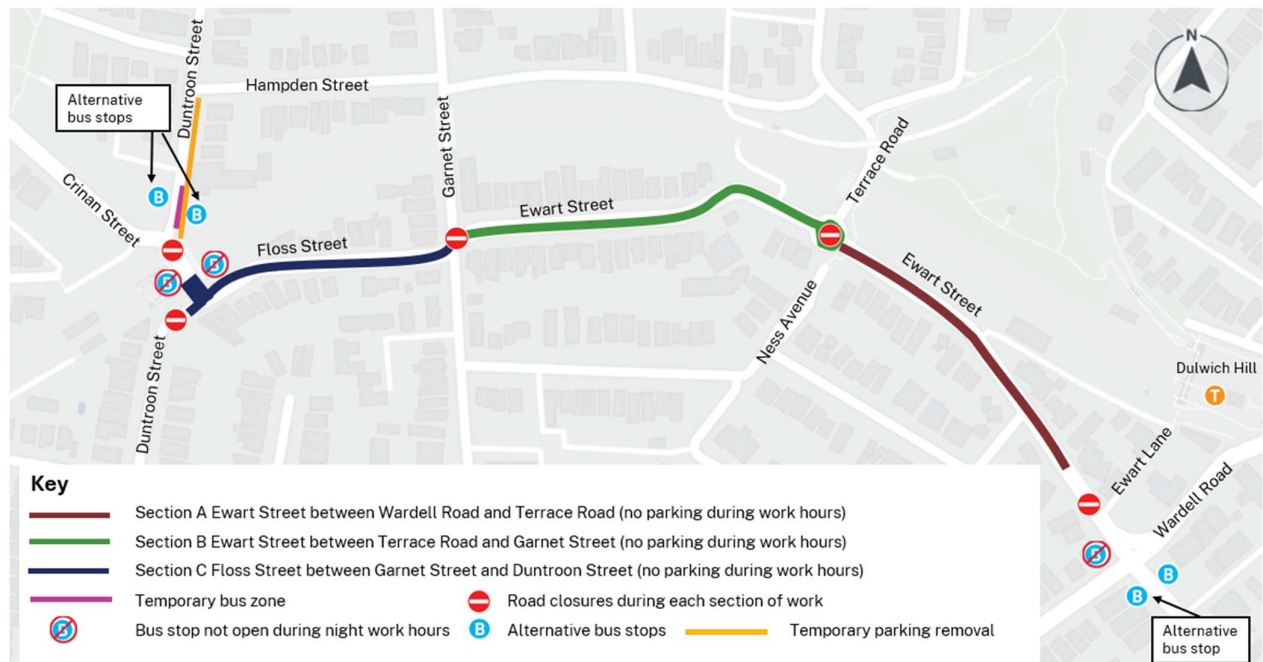
