

Bus zone and parking changes

Campsie Station

September 2026



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport is proposing changes around Campsie Station to support reliable and efficient bus services when the new Southwest Metro opens later this year.

Fare-free Southwest Link buses will stop running when Southwest Metro opens. To prepare for this, Transport is reviewing the future use of temporary bus zones introduced for Southwest Link.

The proposed changes aim to support local bus services and connections to the new Metro at Campsie Station and local parking needs in the area.

What changes are proposed?

Temporary bus zones were introduced on South Parade, Beamish Street and Duke Street when Southwest Link started in September 2024.

The following bus zones will be made permanent to support local bus services:

- South Parade, Campsie (between Harold and Duke streets)
- Anzac Mall, Beamish Street (Stop ID: 219413)

Bus zones on Duke Street, South Parade and Beamish Street will be removed and previous parking arrangements reinstated.

Duke Street, Campsie (south of South Parade)

- Bus zone will be returned to unrestricted parking.

South Parade, Campsie (between Park and Gould streets):

- Bus zone will be returned to unrestricted parking.
- This area will be used by replacement buses when there is planned trackwork on the Metro line.

Beamish Street, Campsie (south of Campsie Street):

- Bus zone will be returned to 1/2P 8:30am – 6pm Mon-Fri and 8:30am – 12:30pm Sat.

When will these changes happen?

These changes will be made as part of bus service planning when Southwest Metro opens.

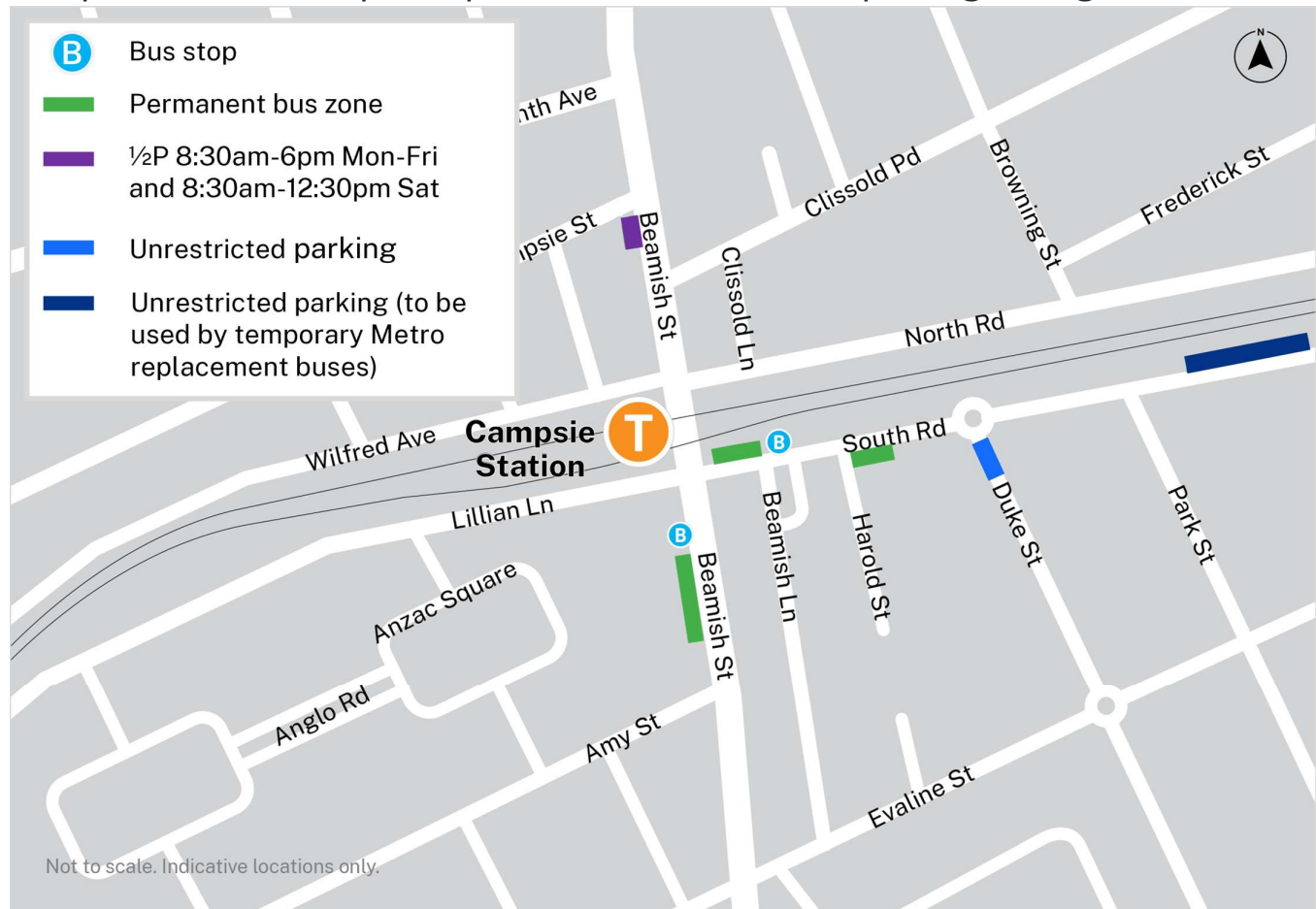
We will notify you closer to the time, before any changes are made.

Why are these changes needed?

The permanent bus zone on Beamish Street and additional bus layover on South Parade will support additional local bus services and improve connections to Campsie Station. We will also simplify and improve bus stop information to make travelling easier for passengers.
