

Bus zone and parking changes

Bankstown Station

September 2026



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport is proposing changes around Bankstown Station to support reliable and efficient bus services when the new Southwest Metro opens later this year.

Fare-free Southwest Link buses will stop running when Southwest Metro opens. To prepare for this, Transport is reviewing the future use of temporary bus zones introduced for Southwest Link.

The proposed changes aim to support local bus services and connections to the new Metro at Bankstown Station and local parking needs in the area.

What changes are proposed?

Temporary bus zones were introduced on South Terrace, Restwell Street and West Terrace when Southwest Link started in September 2024.

The following bus zones will be made permanent to support local bus services:

- Inside the bus interchange on South Terrace.
- On the southern side of South Terrace, between Restwell Street and West Terrace.

Bus zones on Restwell Street and West Terrace will be removed and previous parking arrangements reinstated.

West Terrace (between South Terrace and Raymond Street):

Bus zone will be returned to the previous timed parking arrangements:

- 80-metres 2P 8:30am – 6:30pm Mon-Fri and 8:30am – 12:30pm Sat.

Restwell Street (south of South Terrace):

Bus zone will be returned to the previous timed parking and No parking restrictions.

- 11-metres P5min 8am – 6pm Mon – Sat.
- 8.5-metres No Parking.
- This area will be used by replacement buses when there is planned trackwork on the Metro line.

When will these changes happen?

These changes will be made as part of bus service planning when Southwest Metro opens.

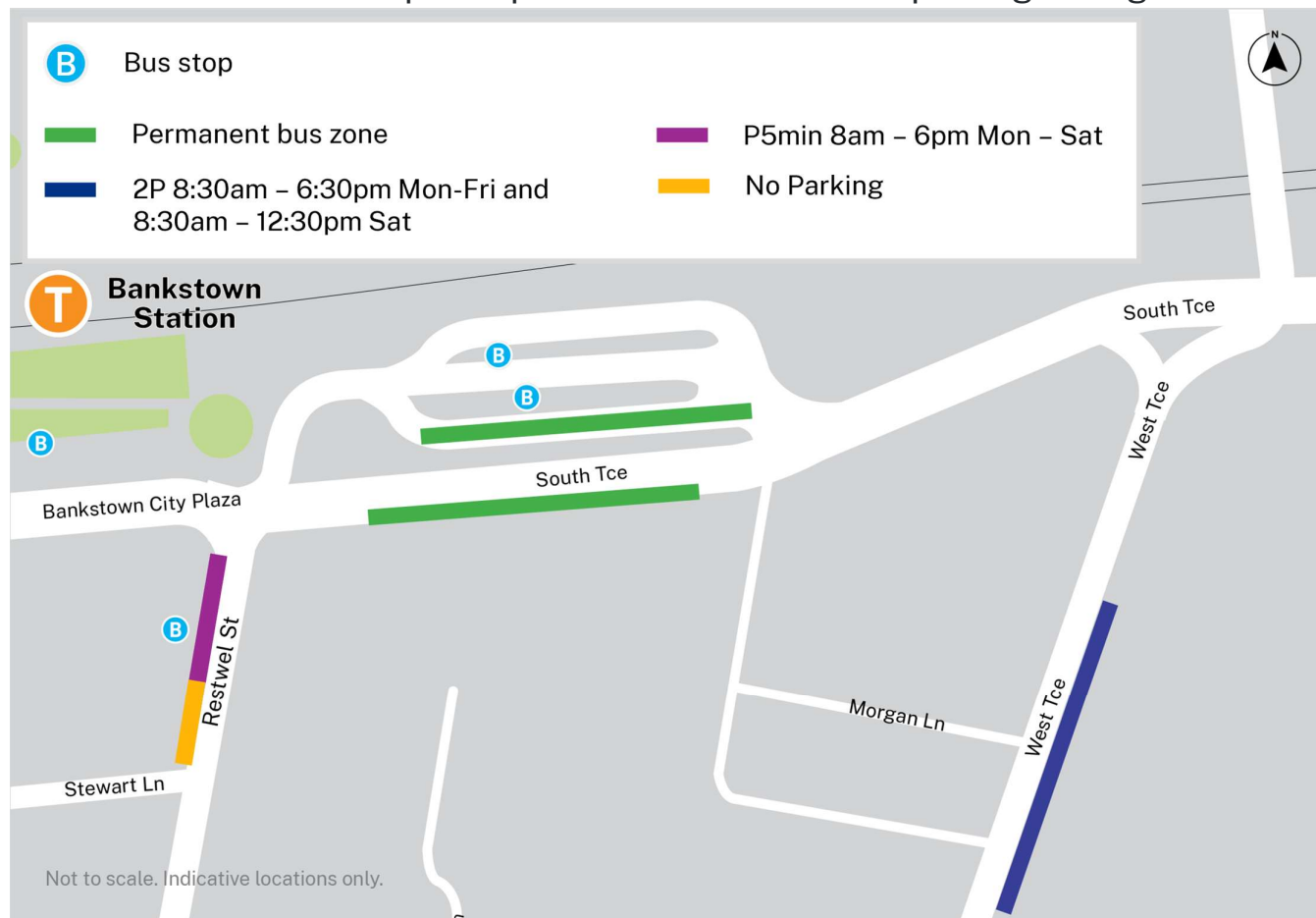
We will notify you closer to the time, before any changes are made.

Why are these changes needed?

The permanent bus zones in the bus interchange and on South Terrace will support additional local bus services connecting passengers to Bankstown Station. This will also provide additional layover capacity and support improved bus connections to Southwest Metro and the Bankstown town centre.
